BACKGROUND:

In support work it is important to be committed to promoting equality, valuing diversity and working inclusively.

Stakeholders need to know that you will oppose all forms of discrimination and have a zero-tolerance approach to bullying, harassment and victimisation. Part of your work will involve identifying and removing or reducing any barriers and inequalities.

TARGET GROUP:

All employees working within housing and health & social care sectors and settings.

COURSE AIMS:

Develop more knowledge, awareness and understanding of the key ideas relating to discrimination, equality and diversity enabling support workers to continue to promote and enhance anti-discriminatory policy within the organisation.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

1. Understand the impact and implications of our own personal attitudes, values, beliefs, prejudices and stereotypes
2. Gain an awareness of workplace responsibilities as stated by the Equality Act 2010
3. Develop a knowledge of the protected characteristics that are covered by the law
4. Recognise what is meant by discrimination and be able to recognise the different types
5. Awareness of cultural sensitivity and celebrating diversity within society
6. Challenge discriminatory attitudes and behaviour effectively
7. Be aware of the importance of equality and diversity training so that the workplace can become more tolerant and understanding.
