

Personal and Professional Boundaries

BACKGROUND:

The nature of the course allows candidates to explore and discuss the finely balanced relationship between client (vulnerable) and staff member (professional) and the development of appropriate professional boundaries. The course focuses on safeguarding staff, clients and the organisation. The importance of dynamic risk assessment, and the dangers of crossing professional boundaries.

5. Use a range of methods to raise concerns, seek advice & information about boundaries
